As an international speaker, Nili has lectured in 9 countries and over 30 cities across North America, including universities such as Penn, Tufts, Northwestern and Brandeis. She has served as Scholar-in-Residence and Keynote Speaker at numerous synagogues, retreats and conferences around the world, including the world-famous *Sinai Indaba* in South Africa, where she addressed audiences of thousands.

She is a Trip Leader for the Momentum (formerly Jewish Women's Renaissance Project), an organization that has brought over 18,000 people to Israel since 2009.
